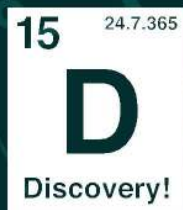

The Michigan Science Center's Sunstruck Educator Kit offers educators the opportunity to enhance current space science curriculum. With a focus on our sun and the tools scientists use to learn more about our solar system, educators can use our kit to provide hands-on activities for children while connecting with Michigan Grade Level Content Expectations. Kits are appropriate for grades 3-12.

There is no training necessary. Each kit includes a flash drive containing use instructions, additional lesson plans, and general background information. Kits may be picked up at the Michigan Science Center or mailed to your location after they have been reserved.
